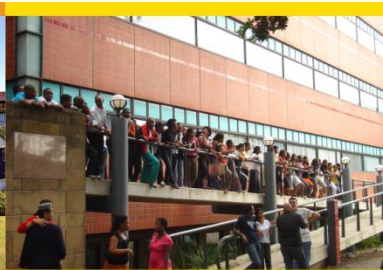

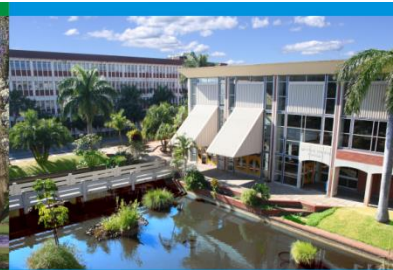

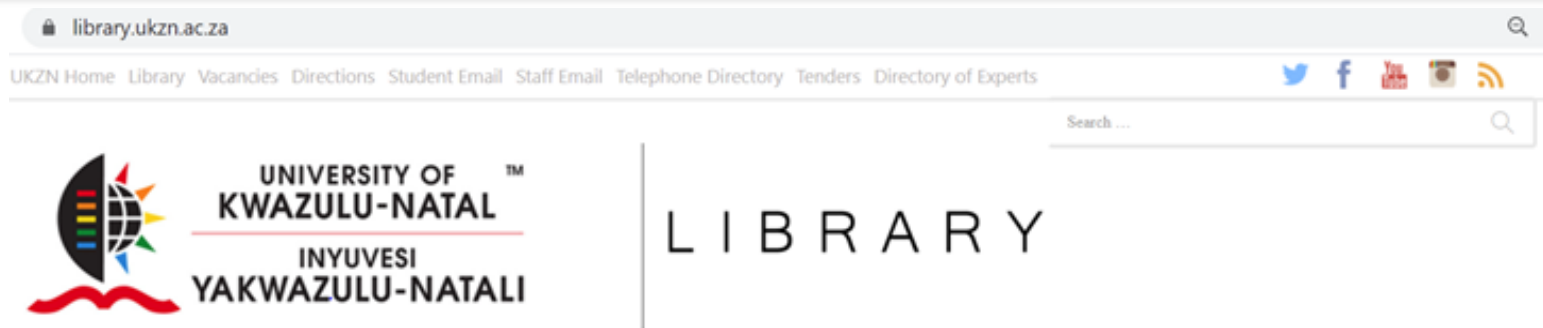


BORROWING LIBRARY RESOURCES

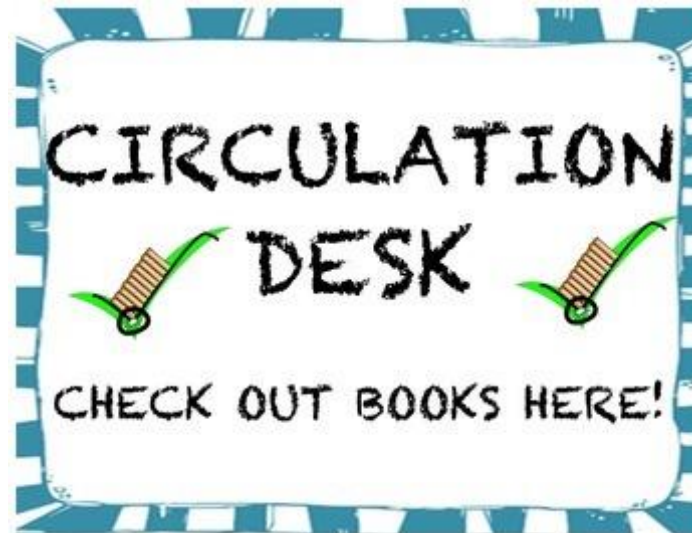

 - Intercampus and interlibrary loan requests are processed.



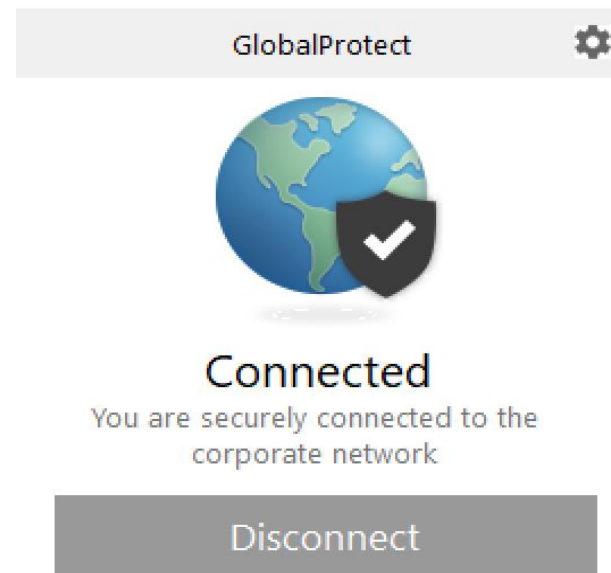
LIBRARY TRAINING
